Unlike conventional floor finish removers, CREW CARE Floor Finish Remover does not contain 2-BE (ethylene glycol butyl ether), APE (alkylphenol ethoxylate), Caustics, or EDTA (Ethylenediaminetetraacetic acid). However, like other conventional floor finish removers, CREW CARE Floor Finish Remover removes most conventional, metal cross-linked floor finishes. This fast-acting and pleasant-to-use stripper removes multiple layers of finish without the use of alkalis or other conventional, harsh components, and it does not contain hazardous or corrosive materials, which could end up in gray water discharge.

CREW CARE Floor Finish Remover is highly concentrated and requires no neutralization prior to floor finish being applied.

Use 1:4 solution (100ml CREW CARE Floor Finish Remover to 400ml cold water).

Mop CREW CARE Floor Finish Remover solution onto the floor. Note: Best results are obtained by working in small areas, a section at a time. Recommended working sections should be no larger than 100 square feet/9 square meters.

Allow CREW CARE Floor Finish Remover to penetrate old floor finish for 5 minutes. Finish will begin to emulsify. NOTE: Do not let the solution remain in contact with flooring for longer than 5 minute intervals as tile or tile coloring can be permanently damaged. Do not use on asphalt tiles.

Scrub the area using a floor machine equipped with a suitable stripping pad, or scrub the floors manually with a suitable scrubber, such as a doodle bug with an attached swivel pad holder.

Pick up the solution with a vacuum or with a mop and bucket.

Mop rinse the floor two times with clean water, and allow the floor to dry completely.

After floor has been stripped according to these instructions, apply CREW CARE Floor Finish PCN 1AB4964 according to its directions.

As with any stripping operation, use extreme caution when walking on the floor while the Floor Finish Remover is in the process of removing the finish. The emulsified floor finish/stripping mixture can be slippery.

Ensure adequate ventilation during use.
